Item 5

In accordance with articles 17 (4) and (5) of the Convention, the Meeting of States parties will elect 12 members of the Committee to replace those whose terms are due to expire on 31 December 2018.

Item 6

Article 28 of the Convention provides that the Secretary-General, as depositary, shall receive and circulate to all States the text of reservations made by States at the time of ratification or accession. It also provides that the Secretary-General shall inform States parties of any reservation withdrawn by notification after such notification is received.¹
