ADOPTION OF THE COMMITTEE'S REPORT ON ITS TWENTY-NINTH SESSION  
(CRC/C/114)

1. The CHAIRPERSON invited the members of the Committee to consider chapter I of the report, "Organizational and other matters".

2. Chapter I was adopted.

3. The CHAIRPERSON invited the Rapporteur to introduce chapter II, section B of the report, entitled "Reports by States parties under article 44 of the Convention", which contained the Committee's concluding observations on the reports of Lebanon, Greece, Gabon, Mozambique, Chile, Malawi, Bahrain and Andorra. Consideration of the initial report of the United Arab Emirates had been postponed to the thirtieth session of the Committee.

4. Ms. KARP (Rapporteur) summarized the issues common to all eight reports, and described the Committee's observations on the reports of Lebanon, Greece, Gabon and Chile.
