ADOPTION OF THE COMMITTEE'S REPORT ON ITS TWENTY-FOURTH SESSION (CRC/C/97)

1. The CHAIRPERSON invited members to consider chapter I, "Organizational and other matters", chapter III, "Overview of other activities of the Committee" and chapter IV, "Draft provisional agenda for the twenty-fifth session", of the report.

2. Chapters I, III and IV of the report were adopted.

3. The CHAIRPERSON invited the Rapporteur to introduce chapter II, section B of the report, entitled "Reports by States parties under article 44 of the Convention", which contained the Committee's concluding observations on the reports of the Islamic Republic of Iran, Georgia, Jordan, Norway, Kyrgyzstan, Cambodia, Malta, Suriname and Djibouti.

4. Mr. DOEK (Rapporteur) described the main aspects of the Committee's concluding observations on each report.
