Decision adopted by the Committee under article 22 of the Convention, concerning communication No. 842/2017^{*}, ^{**}

<i>Alleged victims:</i>	The complainants
<i>State party:</i>	Sweden
<i>Date of complaint:</i>	6 September 2017 (initial submission)
<i>Substantive issues:</i>	Deportation to the Russian Federation; risk of torture

At its meeting on 14 July 2021, the Committee – having been informed that since the expulsion order against the complainants had become time-barred, and they could now submit a new asylum application in Sweden – decided to discontinue the examination of communication No. 842/2017 on the understanding that the complainants would be entitled to submit a new communication to the Committee in the event of a renewed risk of forcible removal from the State party's territory.
