<i>Date of complaint:</i>	15 April 2019 (initial submission)
<i>Substantive issues:</i>	Deportation to Afghanistan; risk of torture

At its meeting on 14 July 2021, the Committee, having been informed that the expulsion order against the complainant had become time-barred, and that he could now submit a new asylum application in Sweden, decided to discontinue the consideration of communication No. 929/2019, on the understanding that the complainant would be entitled to submit a new communication to the Committee in the event of a renewed risk of forcible removal from the State party's territory.
