1. Adoption of the agenda

Under rule 9 of the Committee's rules of procedure, the first item on the provisional agenda of any session shall be the adoption of the agenda, unless the election of officers is required under rule 20. 5. Consideration of reports submitted by parties to the Convention under article 35

At its twenty-sixth session, the Committee will consider the initial reports of Jamaica, Switzerland and Venezuela (Bolivarian Republic of) and the combined second and third reports of Hungary, Mexico and Tunisia.

In pursuance of established practice and in conformity with rule 41 of the rules of procedure, the Secretary-General has informed the parties concerned of the tentative dates on which their reports have been scheduled for consideration by the Committee. A schedule for the consideration of the reports will be set forth in the tentative programme of work, which will be made available on the web page of the Committee.

6. Adoption of lists of issues concerning reports of parties to the Convention

The Committee will adopt list of issues on initial reports. It will also adopt lists of issues prior to reporting, under the simplified reporting procedure, on periodic reports.

7. Cooperation with other United Nations bodies, specialized agencies, organizations of persons with disabilities and other competent bodies

The Committee will discuss how to strengthen cooperation with United Nations bodies, specialized agencies, non-governmental organizations, including organizations of persons with disabilities, and other competent bodies in order to enhance the promotion and protection of the rights of persons with disabilities, including the empowerment and promotion of the rights of women and girls with disabilities. Representatives of such organizations and bodies may seek to address the Committee.

8. General comments

The Committee will continue its work on drafting a general comment on article 27 of the Convention, on the right of persons with disabilities to work and employment. The Committee will review the progress made by the working group established to draft guidelines on the deinstitutionalization of persons with disabilities, including in emergency situations, to supplement the Committee's general comment No. 5 (2017) on living independently and being included in the community.

9. Methods of work of the Committee

The Committee will consider its methods of work.

10. Activities under the Optional Protocol to the Convention

The Committee will consider the communications submitted under the Optional Protocol to the Convention. It will also consider matters related to inquiries under the Optional Protocol.

11. Future meetings

The Committee will be informed of any developments relating to its future meetings. It will also consider its future organization of work.

12. Other matters

Members will discuss any other matters relating to the work of the Committee, as considered necessary.

13. Adoption of the report on the twenty-sixth session

Pursuant to rule 38 bis of its rules of procedure, the Committee may consider and adopt the report on its twenty-sixth session.
