No racial discrimination in any form exists or has ever existed in the Argentine Republic, either in the laws or in the practical application thereof, and the constitutional and legal provisions both at the national and the provincial levels affirm the absolute equality of all inhabitants; the enjoyment of the rights of citizenship is not based on discrimination of this kind either.
