

Note by the Secretary-General

- 1. At its ninety-fifth session, the Committee on the Elimination of Racial Discrimination considered copies of reports and other documentation relating to Trust and Non-Self-Governing territories submitted to it in 2018 in accordance with decisions of the Trusteeship Council and the Special Committee on the Situation with regard to the Implementation of the Declaration on the Granting of Independence to Colonial Countries and Peoples, in conformity with article 15 of the International Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Racial Discrimination. The Committee's expressions of opinion and recommendations¹ were submitted to the General Assembly at its seventy-third session in accordance with article 15 (3) of the Convention, as well as to the United Nations bodies concerned.
- 2. At its 2018 session, the Special Committee continued to follow the work of the Committee on the Elimination of Racial Discrimination and to monitor related developments in the territories, having regard to the relevant provisions of article 15 of the Convention.²
- 3. Any further action that the Special Committee may take in connection with the transmission of information to the Committee under article 15 of the Convention will be brought to the attention of the Committee at a later date, as appropriate.
- 4. In accordance with earlier decisions of the Special Committee and the Trusteeship Council, however, the Secretary-General will make available to the Committee, at its ninety-eighth session, copies of the working papers on the various territories, prepared by the secretariat for the Special Committee and the Trusteeship Council in 2018.
