Subject: The treatment of Egyptians suspected of terrorism abroad and expelled to Egypt (paragraph 16 (c) of the Committee's concluding observations)

The competent authorities have provided the following information:

- 1. The Egyptians expelled to Egypt were treated in accordance with the due process of law, having been presented to the prosecuting authorities directly upon their arrival in the country.
- 2. None of the persons concerned has filed a complaint about ill-treatment, even though Egyptian law allows such persons to lodge complaints with the prison authorities or the Department of Public Prosecutions.
