Note by the Secretary-General

- 1. The forty-first session of the Committee against Torture will be held at the United Nations Office at Geneva (Palais Wilson) from 3 to 21 November 2008. The first meeting of the session will be convened on Monday, 3 November, at 10.30 a.m.
