ADOPTION OF THE COMMITTEE'S REPORT ON ITS TWENTY-THIRD SESSION

1. The CHAIRPERSON invited members to consider chapter I, "Organizational and other matters", chapter III, "Overview of other activities of the Committee" and chapter IV, "Draft provisional agenda for the twenty-fourth session", of the report.

2. Chapters I, III and IV of the report were adopted.

3. The CHAIRPERSON invited the Rapporteur to introduce chapter II, section B of the report, entitled "Reports by States parties under article 44 of the Convention", which contained the Committee's concluding observations on the reports of India, Sierra Leone, Costa Rica, the Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Armenia, Peru, Grenada and South Africa.
