Addendum

1. In conformity with article 72 (4) of the International Convention on the Rights of All Migrant Workers and Members of Their Families, the tenth meeting of the States parties to the Convention will be convened by the Secretary-General at United Nations Headquarters on Tuesday, 29 June 2021, for the purpose of electing seven members of the Committee on the Protection of the Rights of All Migrant Workers and Members of Their Families from a list of persons nominated by States parties, to replace those whose terms are due to expire on 31 December 2021.
